A STUDY OF

“IMPLICATION”

God gives direct statements on some matters.

God implies truth on other matters, which we INFER (conclude and understand).

Classic Example

Mt.22:31 “But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying, 32 I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.”

GOD SAID

- 1) “I am the God of Abraham...Isaac...Jacob”.
- 2) God is the God of the LIVING.
  - a. Not “was” (past tense).
  - b. But “am” (present tense).

IMPLICATION:

Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (though dead physically, so as to BE raised), are STILL ALIVE--in some sense.
