

### LET'S SUPPOSE

- 1) Alfred is "now" right with God because of PRAYER.
- 2) Jane is "not" right with God because she refuses BAPTISM.

#### WHAT IS THEIR STATUS?

- 1) Is Alfred's marriage NOW right with God, while Jane's is NOT right with God?
- 2) Is Alfred NOW truly married to Jane, who is NOT married (not right--adulterous) to him?

#### PRAYER or BAPTISM

- 1) WON'T cause the SUN to rise out of the west instead of the east.
- 2) WON'T cause a "not lawful" union to become a "lawful union".

#### BEGINS -- CONTINUES

##### *Begins*

- 1) D (not for F) + R = A
- 2) M (one unscripturally D) = A

##### *Continues*

- 1) As long as the "marriage" continues.
- 2) Prayer or baptism does not change an "adulterous" relationship into a non-adulterous relationship.
- 3) Adultery must cease for adultery to cease.

### ADULTERY

*Begins* *Continues* (as long as it continues).

Ro.7:2 "For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband. 3 So then if, while her husband liveth, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man."

#### "NO ADULTERER" WILL BE SAVED

1Co.6:9 "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor ADULTERERS, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God."

#### "NO ADULTERER" includes:

- 1) Those committing adultery by ENTERING it.
- 2) Those committing adultery by CONTINUING in it.

Mk.6:17 "For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her. 18 For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife."
