### "IT IS TOO MUCH", #3

#### INTRODUCTION

- I. In two previous lessons on the subject of, "It is Too Much," we noted two things.
  - A. 1st, we noted how Jeroboam first USED that argument to keep the Ten tribes away from Jerusalem to worship God, by saying "It is too much for you to go there."
    - 1. He changed the OBJECT of worship from God to golden calves in Dan and Beersheba.
    - 2. He changed the PLACE of worship from Jerusalem to Dan and Beersheba where the golden calves were located.
    - 3. He then changed the PRIESTHOOD from the Levitical order, to his own order he devised.
    - 4. Then, he changed the DAY of worship from the 7<sup>th</sup> month and 15<sup>th</sup> day to the 8<sup>th</sup> month and 15<sup>th</sup> day.
  - B. 2ndly, we CHALLENGED religious neighbors to truthfully see 2 things: (1) It is too much to ADD human doctrines to the Bible, and (2) it is too much to ADD instrumental music to the singing in worship.
- II. Today, we continue our challenge to the denominational world in 2 more ways "it is too much."

### DISCUSSION

## I. 1st, we say, "It is too much" for you to JUSTIFY YOUR EXISTENCE.

- A. When Jesus built HIS "church", it was His will that IT be the only religious body to exist.
  - 1. He built only ONE institution, the church. Matt. 16:18
  - 2. He had inspiration to record it's ONENESS. Eph. 1:22-23; 4:4; 1 Cor. 12:13
- B. Paul, by inspiration, CONDEMNED denominational-ism, or separate religions.
  - 1. Denominational-ism is simply an attempt to justify DIVISION in the religious world.
  - 2. Paul, by inspiration, says we are to have "no divisions." 1 Cor. 1:10
    - a. This involves "speaking the same thing." 1 Cor. 1:10; 1 Pet. 4:11A
    - b. It involves staying IN the doctrine of Christ, as recorded in the N.T. 2 John 9
    - c. The sinful, divided state of the religious world, consisting now of 58,000 separate, distinct denominations, cannot be justified.
    - d. They exist because they are "no longer" **with** those follow only the N.T. as the will of God. 1 John 2:19
  - 3. People today often "thank God" for the many denominations to give them a choice since they believe different things, BUT it is GOD'S choice that we all be ONE. John 17:20-21

# II. 2<sup>nd</sup>, we say, "It is too much" to wear HUMAN NAMES IN RELIGION.

- A. The ONLY name by which we are to honor God is the name "Christian."
- 1. God revealed this name right after the Gentiles were offered salvation and brought into the church. Isa. 62:5; Acts 10:48; 11:15-18
  - 2. Peter said THIS name, the name "Christian", is **THE NAME** we are to wear that glorifies God for those in HIS church. 1 Pet. 3:21; 4:16 (cf KJV and ASV)
- B. The N.T. plainly teaches that we are to wear "no other name."
  - 1. In Acts 4, Peter (the same apostle who **said** we are to wear the name "Christian", ALSO said we are to have "no other name" than that which involves Christ (as is seen in the name "Christian." Acts 4:11
    - a. Now, we are to understand that it is the **authority** of Christ that is under consideration in this verse.
    - b. However, **in principle**, the expression "no other name" also applies to the name we are to wear to glorify God.
  - 2. In talking with someone in religious matters you may ask, "What are you religiously?"

- a. Without hesitation, they will answer by giving the NAME OF THEIR DENOMINATION, with which they are affiliated.
- b. THEN, when YOU say in response (when they then ask YOU what you are religiously) that your say, **"I am a Christian."**
- c. At that point they IMMEDIATELY come back with the statement, "Oh, I'm a Christian TOO, but I am affiliated with such and such denomination" that they had already named.
- d. Question: Why didn't they say that in the first place?
- e. The Answer: <u>The REASON is, because they basically think MORE</u> of their denominational name than they do the divine name "Christian."
- f. They are wearing one name too many, and we say "It is too much" to wear a human name in religion, and they need to give it up.

### CONCLUSION

- I. It is the ONLY **safe, indisputable** and **right** way to follow only the N.T. in Christianity.
  - A. Are you following only the word of God in the matter of salvation? Acts 2;36-38
  - B. Are you following only the word of God in the matter of worship? Acts 2:42
  - C. Are you following only the word of God in the matter of Christian living? Tit. 2: 11-12
