## THE COMINGS OF CHRIST

INTRODUCTION

- I. At this season of the year, we are made aware of the birth of Jesus.
  - A. Though we do not know the exact day of the year of His birth (and we are not authorized to make a celebration day **of** His birth) we are glad that the world even thinks of Jesus at all—any time of the year.
  - B. In this day of atheism and materialism, we are at least glad there is a crack in the door to bring the full teachings about Christ and His word to the world.
- II. In this lesson we shall speak on "The Comings of Christ", as revealed in scripture.

## I. 1st, we shall consider the FIRST COMING OF CHRIST.

- A. From eternity, God purposed to send Christ into the world. 1Pet.1:19f
  - 1. In Eden, God promised Satan that the Saviour would come. Gen.3:15; Gal.4:4f
  - 2. Old Testament prophets spoke of His coming. Isa.7:14; 53:1-3; 11:1; Zech.6:12f
- B. What if Christ had **not** come?
  - 1. 1<sup>st</sup>, it would mean the prophets were wrong, and the entire Bible of prophecies and fulfillment is unreliable.
  - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup>, the law of Moses (if **it** is reliable) would still be in force, because Christ would not have fulfilled it. Mt.5:17f; Ga.3:19; Col.2:14
  - 3. 3<sup>rd</sup>, it would mean that since the Jews were still under Moses' law, that we non-Jews would still be under the Patriarchal system and probably practicing paganism or idolatry.
  - 4. 4<sup>th</sup>, it would mean that our calendar system would not be B.C. and A.D., but now most all the world recognizes the coming of Christ.
- C. What did Christ **do** when He came?
  - 1. 1st, He fulfilled the law, keeping it perfectly and left us a good example. Mt.5:17; 1Pet.2:21f
  - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup>, Christ performed many miracles that are written to convince unbelievers of His saving power. Jn.20:30f
  - 3. 3<sup>rd</sup>, He gave authoritative teaching that has changed the world.
  - 4. 4<sup>th</sup>, Christ died on the cross to save us from sin's consequences. Jn.19:31-34; Mt.26:28
  - 5. 5<sup>th</sup>, Christ was buried in a borrowed tomb and raised to show His Sonship and offer unto us eternal life. Ro.1:4; 1Co.15:1-4
  - 6. 6th, Christ ascended into heaven to be our King and High Priest. He.8:1; Ac.2:34-36

## II. Now, let's consider the SECOND COMING OF CHRIST.

- A. It was promised in scripture that Christ would come again. Jn.14:1-3; Ac.1:9-11; He.9:28
- B. What will the second coming of Christ bring?
  - 1. 1st, it will bring an **end** to all things temporal and material. 2Pe.3:10
  - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup>, it will bring **deliverance** of the saved to God. 1Co.15:23f
  - 3. 3rd, it will bring the judgment day of the Lord. Jn.5:28f; Mt.25:31f
  - 4. 4th, it will bring the **resurrection** of the dead. Jn.5:28f; 1Th. 4:13-18
- I. Finally, when will He come again? Mt.24:36
- II. It will be a great and glorious day for Christ and the redeemed.
